We work to make the world better for disabled people.</p> <p>Most of our work is in North East England. 	<p>About this job Skills for People is working with Newcastle City Council to help local people with a learning disability and autistic people to have a good life: so they can be healthy, happy and safe.</p> <p>The idea is to help people to get the help they need near where they live. Often this might be about getting some advice, or getting involved with a local group, volunteering or trying a new activity.</p>
	<p>We are employing two 'experts by experience'. (These will be people with a learning disability or autistic people).</p> <p>They will help each person who asks for help, to find out what is in their community to help them have a good life. They will work with them to plan, and make sure they get the support they need.</p>



The Community Connectors will have support to do their job. They will be part of a team, working alongside Skills for People staff and Newcastle City Council staff.
