

The Alan Shearer Activity Centre







FAB Group Fantastic and Brilliant!

For young people with SEND in Newcastle, they meet monthly and also go and visit venues such as the Centre for Life, City Library and the Discovery Museum as 'secret shoppers' to assess them for accessibility.

Masquer-aid

A 12 week programme combining peer support and 'therapeutic education' for young people who have been diagnosed or are waiting an assessment for neurodivergence.

Employability

For 16 - 25 year olds, this mentoring program helps neurodivergent young people to develop skills for the workplace, build confidence and supports with job applications and CV writing.

Peer Support

Based in Prudhoe and Hexham, we host activities and a chance for Neurodivergent young people to connect with their peers and make friends!

A reminder that we host two **inclusive youth groups** every Tuesday, with groups suitable for individuals with physical, sensory, and learning disabilities from the ages of 8 to 14.

Both groups aim to support and empower young people while enhancing mental health and wellbeing in a fun and safe environment. Focusing on personal development, the group will feature tailored activities in relation to independent living, life skills and personal relationships.

Sessions cost just £3 per person, with the cost including all activities, drinks, and snacks.





Are the Sleep Success workshops for you?

If you have a child aged **1 – 19years** of age where 'sleep' is an issue – YES

Tips to try at home to help improve sleep

- 1. No sugar or caffeine after 4pm
- Eat 'sleepy foods' including cheese, cherries and bananas
- Close curtains and dim lights early. Try to make a quiet and relaxing environment 1 hour before bed
- No computers/ phones or T.V 1 hour before bed
- Relaxing activities with your child 1 hour before bed such as reading, drawing or fine motor activities.
- Warm baths and warm PJ's
- Stick to the same routine every night

 Keep 'bedrooms' neutral colours and a relaxing space



What is a 'sleep issue'?

- Difficulties getting to sleep at night
- Difficulties following a routine at night
- Waking throughout the night
- Not able to self-settle
- Not feeling 'tired'
- Difficulties managing behaviour impacting on sleep

Supporting Young People with Selective Mutism

We are pleased to offer this webinar via Zoom on Monday 21st October 2024 at 5.30pm – 6.30pm

Join us for an insightful webinar led by Julie Cota, Specialist Speech and Language Therapist, as she guides you through the nuances of Selective Mutism (sometimes known as Situational Mutism). SM is anxiety based and presents as an individual not being able to speak in certain situations, whilst being able to do so freely in others.

Autism and Mental Health Difficulties Webinar

Monday 4th November 2024 5.30pm – 7.30pm.

It is presented by child and adolescent psychotherapist Carolyn Morgan, looking at Autism and Mental Health Difficulties in Children and Young People.

The mental health needs of people with autism are often overlooked. Problems such as anxiety, depression and obsessive behaviours can be common. It is difficult to find help and support for these issues. For our young people it may be very hard for them to communicate how they are feeling.
